BLAST FROM THE PAST: VISITING OUR BEGINNINGS

MINUTES FROM THE THIRD ANNUAL SESSION OF THE BEULAH BAPTIST ASSOCIATION OCTOBER 6TH, 7TH AND 8TH OF OCTOBER, A. D. 1882

Friday, October 6, 1882

The third annual session of the Beulah Baptist Association convened today, with Elim Church Columbia County Florida. The Introductory Sermon was preached by Elder Ben. R. Mosely from Prov. XI chapter 25 verse "The liberal soul shall be made fat."

After an intermission of one hour, for refreshments, the body assembled in the church, and after prayer by Elder K. Chambers, was called to order by Elder B. R. Mosely, former clerk, the former Moderator, Elder Wm. M. Davis, being absent. The letters from the various churches were read by Elder G. T. Leiter and Bro. T. W. Getzen, and the names of messengers enrolled as will be seen in the statistics of the churches on another page. A ballot was then taken for permanent officers which resulted in the election of Hon. Thos. W. Getzen, Moderator, Elder Robt. F. Rogers, Clerk, and Bro. Thos. S. Chalker, Treasurer....

Saturday, October 7, 1882

The session opened with singing and prayer by Elder A. J. Cone.

The Committee on Deceased Ministers and Deacons made the following report which was adopted: We are thankful that all of our Ministers and Deacons have been spared that they may yet "work in the masters vineyard," except, one aged and afflicted brother, F. S. Hastings, who was a Deacon of Mount Pleasant Church....

Committee on Sabbath Schools: Report that it is much to be regretted that we hear of but four Sunday Schools in all of the churches composing this Association, viz: Lake City, Lake Butler, Elim and Mount Pleasant, and some of them not in very prosperous condition, perhaps from want of efficiency in officers, or Teachers, or for lack of common propriety and zeal on the part of parents and church members, whose duty it is to remove every obstacle out of the way and see that the proper persons are worked in the proper places and great good will be the result of each efforts; we regard the Sunday School as second to no interest at present, because, it is in the interest of the young, which is the hope of our country. The Sunday School then, is a great means of improving the mind, and employing the time religiously, and every church could and should have one under its own immediate supervision and control; it should be denominational, as no church could afford to teach, or handle, the word of God deceitfully. We therefore trust each church may be able to send to the next session of this Association, a report of a good, lively working Sunday School. John G. Taylor, Chairman.

Sabbath Morning, October 8th 1882

The Missionary Sermon was preached in the Church at 11 a.m. by Elder R. F. Rogers to a very large and attentive congregation from the text "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" Rom. X and 13th verse...


